BURSARIES

Bursaries are means-tested. They are offered to students whose parents can contribute to fees, but who are unable to meet the full fees. Parents are required to submit financial details annually to show income and expenditure. Bursaries may be combined with scholarships.

It is recognised that the judgements about what sacrifices a family should make to pay school fees will be personal and the level of awards is therefore not rigid. The award of a bursary is specifically to allow a child whose parents may not otherwise be able to afford tuition fees to benefit from a place at our school. The award is not intended to support a pre-existing lifestyle. The Governors therefore consider that the following would not be consistent with the award of a bursary:

- 1. Household income (gross income) in excess of £65,000
- 2. Net assets should not exceed £300,000
- 3. Substantial savings or investments of more than £60,000
- 4. Receipt of any means-tested State Benefit
- 5. If only one parent is employed (unless one is prevented from doing so through incapacity)
- 6. More than one property
- 7. Investment in significant home improvements
- 8. Mortgages on excessively expensive properties
- 9. Substantial equity in homes
- 10. Frequent or expensive holidays
- 11. New or luxury cars
